

Eligibility criteria for applications

1. Application must be received before the deadline of 17 October 2016
2. It must be **complete** and **in English language**, including specifically:
3. A full CV
4. A letter of motivation which also reasons which of the following three topics the authors is mostly interested to work on in his/her educational resources:
 - Topic 1: Identity and diversity: the challenges facing history textbook authors
 - Topic 2: Learning about positive encounters with the other
 - Topic 3: Learning about emotive and controversial issues and suggesting alternatives

We are seeking for applicants who

- Live and work in Euro-med region
- Are highly motivated
- Represent educators in primary and secondary schools, curriculum developers, authors of textbook and other teaching tools, teacher pre-service and in-service trainers, assessment experts, advisors and inspectors, educational staff in museums and institutes, board members of member associations and trainee teachers
- Holds experiences with the development of transnational and innovative educational resources in history and citizenship education and have experience in collecting source materials
- Willing to learn and collaborate in a transnational team
- Have a working level of English.

What are expected from the authors?

- To work on the development of exemplar lessons that demonstrate how the recommendations from the guidebook for history textbook authors can be applied in practice.
- To peer review and support the development of educational resources by other authors in the project.
- To help with collection of additional sources from his/her own country needed for the existing educational resources developed by other authors in the project.
- To research and work in between meetings to prepare material and activities for discussion, testing and further development at meetings. Then to take on follow-up work after meetings.
- To pilot of developed materials in the project in practice and possibly present them to local public and at EUROCLIO events.
- To take part in three 2-day development meetings mostly during the weekend (once in 2016 and twice in 2017). These meeting will take place in Cyprus and Lebanon.
- First development meeting will take place in Nicosia (Cyprus) on **19-21 November 2016**. Candidates must be available to attend this meeting. Dates of other 2 meetings will be communicated after the first meeting.

- To take part in online working meetings in addition to face-to-face meetings.

What is offered to the candidates?

The authors will receive an opportunity

- To become part of an international and professional team.
- To enrich and broaden understanding about intercultural citizenship in different country contexts.
- To enhance their experiences in development of innovative and transnational educational materials on specific topics identified in the project.
- To travel abroad and explore different cultural aspects.
- To work and get support from professional trainers with specific expertise in the field needed throughout the development of educational resources
- Entitled to a fee of 200 euros for the work.

Coverage of costs

- Team members' accommodation will be provided in double rooms due to budget limitations. In case candidates wish to be upgraded to single rooms, they will need to cover the difference fee between double and single rooms.
- Cost for the meals, local transport and cultural programme during the meetings will be fully covered within the project.
- Travel costs to development meetings including costs for visa will be covered within the project.
